Presenters will be notified no later than **Monday, August 15, 2022**, if their proposals have been accepted.

Accepted presenters will be asked to provide a professional headshot or high-resolution jpeg photo and a short bio for inclusion in the conference program.

Tips for Creating a Successful Proposal:

- Clearly and thoroughly complete each portion of the proposal form.
- If feasible, connect the topic of the session to the central theme or one of the three conference themes.
- Clearly state the goals and objectives of the session.
- Focus the topic so that the presentation fits within the allotted time frame.
- Target the topic to a mixed audience of faculty, staff, administrators, and graduate students.
- Include an interactive component (if appropriate).
